PBS Notice:

The PBS Safety Net in a calendar year usually resets at the beginning of each year, 1 January.

On 1 January 2024, the PBS Safety Net thresholds were updated to:

- \$277.20 for concession card holders
- \$1,647.90 for general patients.

Before you meet the threshold, each medicine will cost up to:

- \$7.70 for concession card holders
- \$31.60 for general patients.

Once you reach the threshold, you'll need to apply for a <u>PBS Safety Net card</u> to get cheaper medicines.

Your medicine will then either:

- be free for concession card holders
- cost up to \$7.70 for general patients.

When there are 2 or more brands of the same medicine, they may have different prices. If you choose a more expensive brand it may cost you more."
